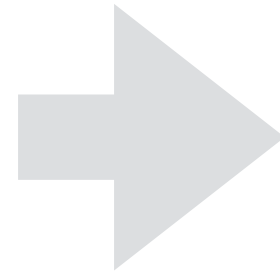
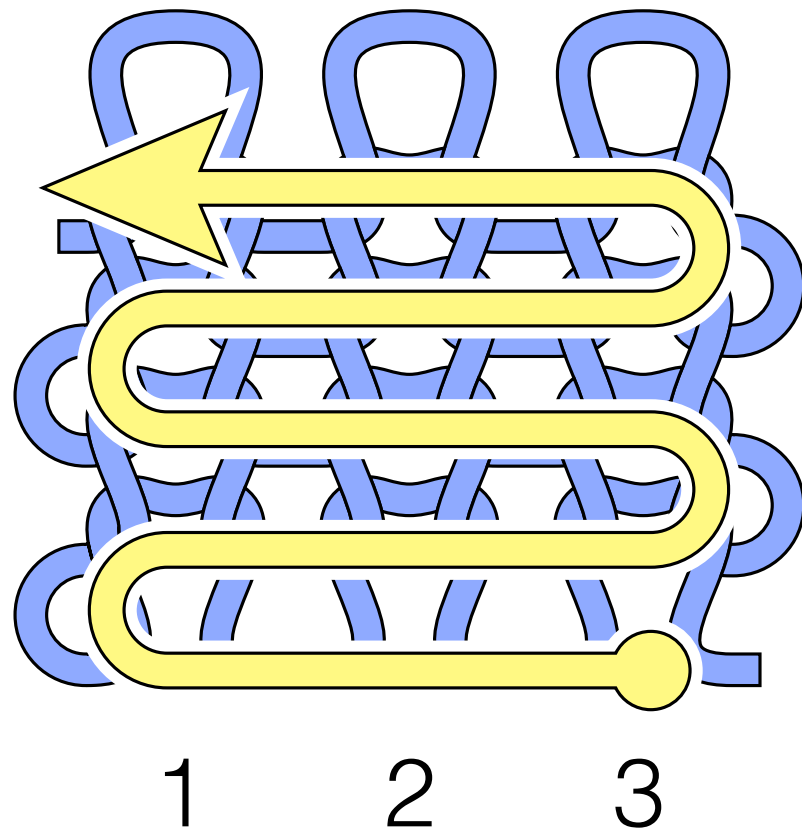


A single loop,

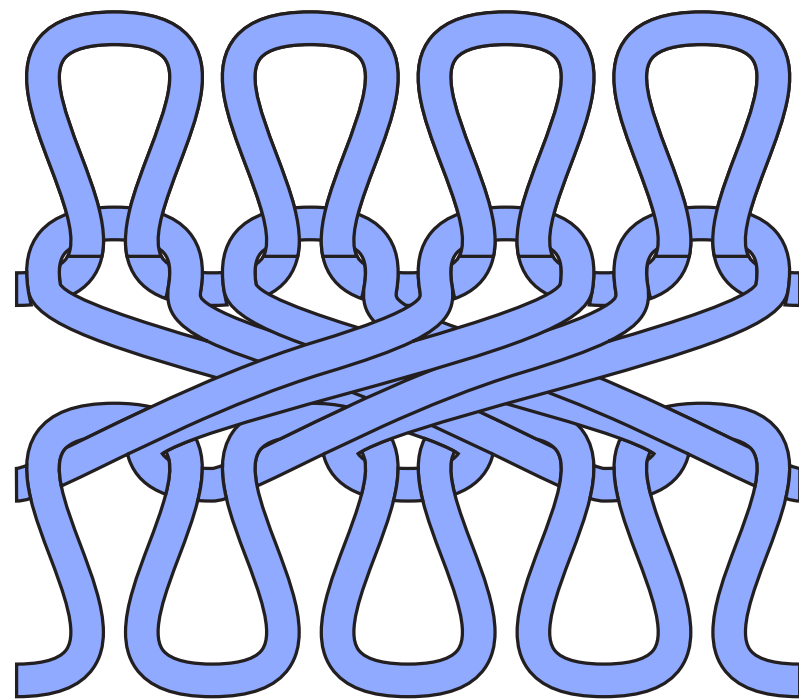


local texture:
